



- TENTS, Tents, and Tents - At least 1 tent for every 3 to four girls in your level, depending on level & tent size. Please see your local friendly camp director for help determining how many you many need. (Don't forget one or two for you and your assistants).
- Hammer(s) for tent stakes / Small tool kit with scissors, screw drivers, and pliers.
- Small nails, screws, and/or tacks, bungie cords. (Optional, but handy for hanging/securing things)
- 2 Canopies per Level
- 1 Broom
- 1 Rake and 1 Shovel
- 1 First Aid Kit with extra Band-Aids
- Rope for Clothesline/Cover for eating area
- Clothespins
- Tarp 10x12 (More than one if you do not have a canopy or cannot borrow a canopy)
- Masking Tape (to mark things not marked)
- Duct Tape, 1 to 2 Rolls
- Permanent Markers
- Old Throw Rugs (for inside of your tent to help keep dirt out of sleeping bag)
- 2-3 Flashlights with extra batteries
- Towels & Washcloths for the forgetful
- Baby Wipes / Hand Sanitizer
- 2 Small Card Tables - not mandatory but very helpful for campsite
- 2-4 Plastic Tablecloths (90" long)



- Camping Chairs
- 2-3 Empty refillable water bottles for youth who forget theirs.
- Extra Travel Size Soap, Toothbrushes, Deodorant for the forgetful ☺
- Items for decorating level area
- Items for level skit
- Extra t-shirt for those who forget the "modest" in modest swim-suit and attire. (Does not have to be new, just clean)
- Extra sweat pants (See above note ☺)
- Extra work gloves (Again for the forgetful)
- Love, Patience, Adventures Spirit and Your Inner Young Women.

*Cell Service is extremely limited and so are power outlets.

*If you bring "treats" in the form of food, PLEASE make sure they are in a sealed /lock top container or check them in to the camp kitchen. We have a strict policy against inviting bears and their friends into the tents.
